



# PUNS News Bulletin

## Reminders

Selection for Adult Waiver Services:

- Completed as funds become available
- Based on the cumulative length of time on the PUNS database in the “Seeking Services” Category
- At selection, the individual is notified via USPS Mail
- The individual’s ISC (Independent Service Coordinator) is also notified
- Please remember to promptly inform your ISC of any address or phone number changes

## Important Note

Please be advised:

- If you decline services at the current time, you may be placed in the “Planning” category with PUNS. This will NOT impact your ability to receive funding when you are ready. You must still update with PUNS yearly in the “Planning” category.

**You MUST keep your NOTIFICATION LETTER AS EVIDENCE that you are able to receive funding.**

## New Information

- The selection notification letter does not have an expiration date and must be kept by the individual
- Once selected, an individual may use their letter at any time in the future; It does not expire
  - EXCEPT IF:
    - The individual had services through PUNS and chose to leave those services (i.e. moved out of state)
- Their selection letter is NOT voided by declining services. If they choose not to enroll in services now, they can in the future when the services would best meet their needs but must have an original notification letter.
- When the need arises they may contact their ISC (CISA) and use their selection letter at any time.
