The training will include opportunities for practice, collaboration, and discussion. Participants are encouraged to review the current sources of student data that inform their IEP writing in preparation for our session.

Session Objectives:

- Participants will identify the elements of a PLAAFP section and write data-driven PLAAFP statements.
- Participants will write standards-aligned SMART IEP goals based on Present Level statements.
- Participants will use strategies and organizational tools to develop a sustainable progress monitoring plan.
