



# COMMUNITY COLLEGE INITIATIVE

## Checklist

The following is information needed by the Division of Rehabilitation Services (DRS) to be reviewed for possible financial assistance in attending Community College:

- Copy of your current IEP and/or other documents from medical professionals substantiating your disability/diagnosis.
- Most recent Evaluation, Re-evaluation, or Psychological testing done in high school that confirms academic aptitude. (Most recent testing should be within the last 3 years and completed on adult scales)
- ACT or SAT Test Results.
- High School Transcripts – indicating courses taken, grades, and completion.
- Letter of Support from a high school teacher, counselor, or someone that can speak to your ability to do college level work.
- FASFA Confirmation/Denial Letter.
- Student Aid Report (SAR) – this is a detailed report, which you will receive from the FAFSA website showing the information that you put on your FAFSA application.
- Copy of your most recent Income Tax Return – if under the age 24, a copy of your parents' income tax return.
- Acceptance Letter from the Community College you are planning to attend.
- Copy of Community College Placement Test Results.
- Letter of Confirmation that you have registered with an office of disability supports.
- Course Program Information – indicating the program description and courses required for your degree or certificate program.
- Tuition Bill – if you have already enrolled. This will include any grants or scholarships applied.
- Copy of School Schedule – if you already enrolled & Source of
