





# Top 10 Autism Apps



## Voice Meter

A visual voice meter with adjustable sensitivity to help kids monitor the volume of their own voice.



## Turn Taker

Uses illustrated social story to teach turn taking. Customizable sharing timer and visuals indicating My Turn, Your Turn, and Finished.



## Time Timer Visual Time

Helps individuals visualize time.



## Hidden Curriculum

Real-life scenarios to teach about unwritten social rules.



## Work System

Customize a work system task list to foster independence.




## Book Creator Free

Allows you to create choice boards using your own photos, text, and music.



## Calm Counter Social Story

This visual and audial tool helps people self-calm when they are angry or anxious. A helpful feature is the prompt to count down from 10-1 and take a deep breath.
